Our goal is to create unique spaces and products by blending the old with the new, transforming recycled materials into pieces that offer fresh sensations and experiences.

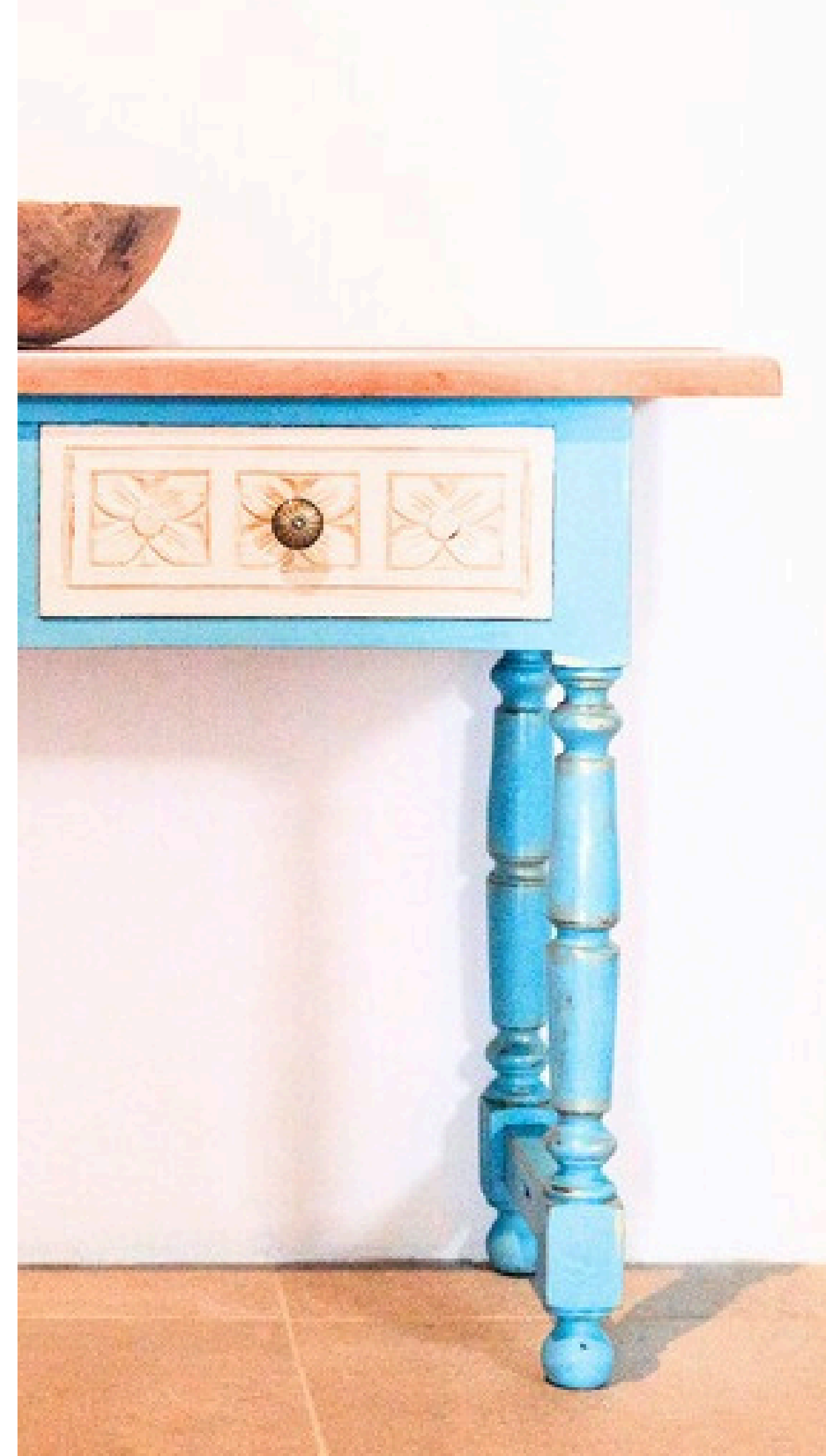
We are committed to recycling and conservation, giving renewed opportunities to existing elements.

“VINTAGE” STYLE

By using various painting techniques, sanding, and applying waxes, we expand the decorative possibilities of each piece of furniture.

These techniques allow us to achieve finishes in "antique" or "distressed" styles, as well as conceal dents and imperfections.

Playing with waxes gives us the ability to transform a dull piece of furniture into one with character and history.



NATURAL WOOD

It is crucial to take care of wooden furniture, as they are scarce resources and represent some of the best available pieces. Removing old varnishes, worn waxes, and dirt allows us to enjoy lighter and more contemporary pieces.

Transforming the "grandmother's furniture" into something modern is as simple as allowing the natural colors of the wood to shine.

We employ various stripping techniques to achieve this natural result without damaging the furniture or contaminating the environment.





CREATING STYLES

WASH PAINTING

Depending on the type of wood, it can range from very light to dark tones, so we expand our options by using 'paint washing' techniques to lighten or darken the piece as needed.

Additionally, wax patinas are an option to protect, decorate, and even change the color of our wooden piece.

STRIPED STYLE

Even something as simple as an outdoor broom can offer the possibility of creating a striped paint effect, whether with vertical lines or by blending them to create unique patterns on the surface.

CREATING WOOD GRAIN STYLE WITH PAINT

With a variety of colors and a special technique, we create wood grain patterns to achieve an exceptional finish, astonishingly mimicking the texture and appearance of real wood on all flat surfaces

AGING WOOD

Sometimes there arises the need to age wood. With a few taps and careful techniques, we can transform a new piece of wood into something that appears very old, giving it a more rustic style while always preserving the beauty of natural woods.

THE POWER OF MIXING

The most fun part about transforming furniture is that imagination knows no bounds when it comes to styles. Mixing colors or painting techniques can completely change the look of a piece.

Our color and wood combination projects have brightened many corners. This fusion allows us to maintain the charm of a rustic corner with a modern touch.

We focus on details to build bespoke furniture, using the right paints and accessories for each project.

Once upon a time...

In an antique shop, a grey piece of furniture languished until a family rescued it. With care and affection, they transformed it into a perfect bathroom cabinet. Now, that worn-out piece shines with new life, becoming an essential fixture for the whole family..



With love and care, we transformed a manually stripped piece of furniture until it reached its desired state. It was cleaned and varnished for protection. The countertop was adapted to install marble sinks, and golden handles were added for towels. A unique and functional piece for the bathroom.

The next step in this project will be adding drawers to streamline the daily routine. We will utilize the wooden front of the furniture to create the drawer front and incorporate push-to-open hinges to modernize storage. With this enhancement, the piece will not only be functional but also modern and stylish.



Once upon a time...

There was a brown wooden wardrobe with black knobs and low round legs. It was painted in 'stone white', with a vintage style on the door achieved through sanding technique, and varnished over the entire surface for protection."



Transforming...

Inclined legs were added for a more modern touch, raising the furniture a few centimeters. White knobs typical of Ibiza were chosen, and varnish was applied over the entire surface for protection. Voilà!"





Once upon a time...

There was a brown wooden nightstand, purchased second-hand. It had copper metal handles and low, round legs.



Transforming...

It was revamped with terracotta-colored chalk paint and sanded on the countertop and drawers. A white paint wash was applied to lighten the dark wood. New high, inclined legs and round knobs in gold and pink tones were added to give it an elegant touch



Once upon a time...

There was a disassembled wardrobe in pieces. It was a dark brown color, with round legs and misaligned doors



Transforming...

It was painted in 'neptune blue', with a two-tone sanding effect, blue and beige, on the doors. The doors were properly screwed and squared. Inclined legs were added along with recycled knobs from another piece of furniture, painted gold.

To complete the set, a matching bedside table was found, also painted in 'neptune blue'. Together, they transformed the baby's room into a cheerful and cozy space, perfect for the child's well-being and growth

Once upon a time...

Mercedes' desk, dating back to the 1940s/50s, was forgotten in a corner because it didn't fit with the current décor. With feelings of nostalgia, it was given new life and purpose, transforming this magnificent, high-quality piece.



The woodworm was treated, the woods were restored, and several coats of "stone white" paint were applied to add luminosity.

The metals were cleaned to restore their original color



Once upon a time...

There was a fantastic gift that needed attention: a faded fire truck, with paint eaten away by the sun, areas rusted, and missing screws in the wheels.



Transforming...

Treating the rust, polishing the "hull," painting the missing areas, and replacing nonexistent parts with black spray paint in previously silver areas, it's as simple as that to enjoy this special toy once again.

A completely white tall table, lacking grace and personality

Once upon a time...

A chest of drawers made of chestnut wood, damaged in some areas, with round wooden knobs, looking for a new home



Transforming...

With dedication and hard work, the piece was prepared for black paint. The doors were cut to customize them with "wicker fabric," and "push to open" hinges were added for a more modern opening. The final touch was to add some new black handles.
